Supervisor Wist gave the floor to the public. Kermit Mott asked what the maximum cost would be for the approved contracts with Griffith Engineering. Wist stated it would be \$540,200 plus an additional 215,000. Mott spoke on the comprehensive plan and the current status of the plan. Wist has not received the final copy. Once the Town receives the final copy and is satisfied, the town will hold a public hearing which will include a SEQR review for final approval. Mott spoke on the Oquaga Lake Sewer project. Wist explained that they will be advertising for an RFQ for engineering services. Delaware Engineering has provided the Town with a sample RFQ and scope of work. Engineering firms interested must be willing to start May 1, and the town will pay half the cost upfront. Mott spoke on the town board helping the Code Enforcement Officer with enforcing the local laws. The town board will need to review the fee structure. A recommendation was made in the past by the Village Planning Board to do a feasibility study. The feasibility study would show the work load and how things would work. The Code Enforcement Officer would work for all three municipalities and maintain office hours. The upcoming Trout 5K run was discussed. The Chamber of Commerce will need to provide the Town with proof of insurance for the use of the Highway Garage parking lot.

No Dog Control report was received.

The Assessor's report was reviewed. On a motion made by Alice Ray, seconded by Dan Andresen and all approved the Assessor's report.

The Minutes of March 12, 2024 were reviewed. On a motion made by Alice Ray seconded by Shane Lester and all accepted the Minutes of March 12, 2024.

The Clerk's report of 3/2024 was presented to the Board. On a motion made by Alice Ray, seconded by Jay Vandermark and all approved the Clerk's report of 3/2024.

The Monthly report was presented to the Board. On a motion made by Dan Andresen, seconded by Shane Lester and all approved the Monthly report for February 2024.

Supervisor Wist spoke on committee reports. The new security system has been installed and will be operational by the end of the week. The town justice department was awarded a JCAP grant in the amount of \$20,971.00 for security upgrades such as new cameras, a new security system, silent alarms/panic buttons as well as office furniture.

Wist received a proposal from Delta Engineering for engineering services for the end of Farnham Road Realignment project. The Town of Sanford wishes to realign the approach to and intersection of Farnham Road with NYS Rt. 41, residents affected have been notified. On a motion made by Dan Andresen, seconded by Jay Vandermark and all approved that Supervisor Wist sign the proposal with Delta Engineering to provide professional engineering services for the Farnham Road realignment project in the amount of \$24,400.

Supervisor Wist gave the floor to Town Clerk, Alison Lang. Lang received \$100 scholarship from the Broome County Association of Tax Collector and Receivers Association to cover the registration fee for the upcoming NYSATRC conference in June. Lang is currently the president of the Association.

Bills were presented to the Board.
