Supervisor Kenny Wist called the Meeting to order at 7:00pm with the Pledge of Allegiance led by Jay Vandermark at the Town Hall, 91 Second Street, Deposit, New York 13754.

Supervisor Wist gave the floor to Dan Griffiths from Griffiths Engineering. Dan gave an update on the new highway garage. An overview of the site plan, building layout plan and storm water management were discussed.

Supervisor Wist spoke on the Oquaga Lake Sewer report. On a motion made by Dan Andresen, seconded by Shane Lester and all accepted the Oquaga Lake Sewer report. A meeting regarding bubblers/ice eaters will be held on Tuesday, July 16th at 1pm. Wist spoke on Delaware Engineering and the Town of Sanford securing a \$50,000 Engineering Planning Grant (EPG) award. This funding will allow for the Town to conduct Inflow and Infiltration (I&I) investigations into the sanitary sewer collection system for the Oquaga Lake Sewer District. Mark Millspaugh spoke on the work schedule, he suggested they should move the schedule up due to the weather. On a motion made by Shane Lester, seconded by Jay Vandermark and all agreed to approve the contract with Delaware Engineering to provide professional engineering services relative to the EPG award for the Oquaga Lake Sewer District.

Supervisor Wist gave the floor to the guests. Kermit Mott questioned if the Comprehensive Plan had been approved. The Town of Sanford Comprehensive Plan has been approved. Paul VanSlyke spoke on the wind turbines. The noise levels are causing difficulty sleeping in the house when the windows are shut, the sound vibrates off the house. Also, when the turbines are not moving there is a constant hum.

No Dog Control Officer or Assessor's report were received.
