RESOLUTION ADOPTING LOCAL LAW NO. 2-2024

At a regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Sanford, held at Sanford Town Hall, 91 Second Street, Deposit, New York on the 8th day of October, 2024, the following resolution was offered and seconded as follows:

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Sanford at its regular meeting held on September 10, 2024, introduced proposed Local Law No. 2 of the Year 2024, entitled, "A LOCAL LAW TO OVERRIDE THE TAX LEVY LIMIT ESTABLISHED IN GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW §3-C"; and

WHEREAS, at said meeting, the Town Board gave notice that a public hearing will be held regarding said proposed Local Law on October 8, 2024 at 7:00 p.m. at the Town Hall; and

WHEREAS, said public hearing was duly held on the 8th day of October, 2024 at 7:00 p.m., at which all parties in attendance were permitted an opportunity to speak in support of or in opposition to said proposed Local Law, or any part thereof; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of this proposed Local Law does not constitute an "action", as that term is defined by the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) and its implementing regulations and, thus, no formal environmental review is required; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Sanford, after due deliberation, finds it in the best interest of the Town to adopt said local law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board of the Town of Sanford hereby adopts Proposed Local Law No. 2 of the Year 2024 as Local Law No. 2 of the Year 2024 entitled "A LOCAL LAW TO OVERRIDE THE TAX LEVY LIMIT ESTABLISHED IN GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW §3-C"; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Town Clerk be and hereby is directed to enter said Local Law in the minutes of this meeting and to give due notice of the adoption of said Local Law to the Secretary of State; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution will take effect immediately upon filing with the Department of State.

TOWN OF SANFORD
LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF THE YEAR 2024

A LOCAL LAW TO OVERRIDE THE TAX LEVY LIMIT
ESTABLISHED IN GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW §3-C

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Sanford as follows:

Section 1. Legislative Intent

It is the intent of this local law to override the limit on the amount of real property taxes that may be levied by the Town of Sanford pursuant to General Municipal Law §3-c, and to allow the Town of Sanford to adopt a budget for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2025 and ending December 31, 2025 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the “tax levy limit” as defined by General Municipal Law §3-c.

Section 2. Authority

This local law is adopted pursuant to subdivision 5 of General Municipal Law §3-c, which expressly authorizes the Town Board to override the tax levy limit by the adoption of a local law approved by vote of at least sixty percent (60%) of the Town Board.

Section 3. Tax Levy Limit Override

The Town Board of the Town of Sanford, County of Broome, is hereby authorized to adopt a budget for the 2025 fiscal year that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the amount otherwise prescribed in General Municipal Law §3-c.

Section 4. Remainder

Except as hereinabove amended, the remainder of the Local Laws of the Town of Sanford shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Separability

The provisions of this Local Law are separable and if any provision, clause, sentence, subsection, word or part thereof is held illegal, invalid, unconstitutional, or inapplicable to any person or circumstance, such illegality, invalidity or unconstitutionality, or inapplicability shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, clauses, sentences, subsections, words, or parts of this local law or their application to other persons or circumstances. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this local law would have been adopted if such illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional provision, clause, sentence, subsection, word or part had not been included therein, and as if such person or circumstance, to which the local law or part thereof is held inapplicable, had been specifically exempt therefrom.

Section 6. Effective Date

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
